

**INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL "REHMAT-UL-LIL-ALAMIN CONFERENCE"**

Director Student Affairs, Department of Islamic Studies in Government College, Women University Faisalabad, in collaboration with the Ministry of Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony and Message of Pakistan, organized a two-day International Virtual "Rehmat-ul-Lil-Alamin Conference" on Wednesday, October 13-14, 2021. The conference was attended by scholars and shaykhs from Pakistan, Morocco, Libya, Iraq, Damascus, Australia, and India. A total of 45 research and scholarly articles were presented at the two-day conference. The aim was to highlight various facets of Uswa-e-Hasnah that is a constant source of guidance for society. On October 15, 2021, a one-day online international webinar "Contemporary Urdu Naat" was organized by the Department of Urdu and the Directorate of Student Affairs. It was presided over by Vice-Chancellor GC Women University, Faisalabad Prof. Dr. Robina Farooq, and Prof. Dr. Riaz Majeed. A genre like Naat seems to be a better creation for composing poetry, Dr. Aziz Ahsan (Karachi) remarked. He further added that literature is of two types, one is emotional and the other is informative. Impressionist literature has precedence because it creates passion and enthusiasm. Prof. Dr. Taqi in his keynote address on Naat said that Naat is not only the fulfillment of humanity but also a great aspect of humanization. Among the special guests, Prof. Dr. Khawaja Ikramuddin (India), while talking about Naat poetry, linked other languages with Naat and shed



light on the tradition of Sanskrit and Bengali Naats. Rahmani (USA), Mr. Mubeen Mirza (Karachi), Dr. Shabbir Qadri (Faisalabad), Dr. Sahibzada Ahmad Nadeem (Sargodha), Dr. Kashif Irfan (Islamabad) and expressed their views on contemporary Naatiya literature. Prof. Dr. Shabbir Ahmad Qadri performed the duties of director. The seminar was attended by Ms. Bazgha Qandil, Ms. Tayyaba Nighat, Dr. Bushra Alamuddin, Dr. Shazia Andalib, Afshin Shaukat, Azmi Bashir, and students of the Urdu Department attended the webinar.

POLICY DEVELOPMENT FOR POLLUTION CONTROL AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

One Day Webinar on Policy Development for Pollution Control and Sustainable Development " in the Video conference room, GCWUF was successfully held by the Department of Chemistry. Prof. Dr. Robina Farooq, Vice-Chancellor GC Women University was the Patron of the event. Dr. Zill-i-Huma Nazli, Chairperson Department of Chemistry, Coordinator of Science and Technology, was convener and Dr. Farhat Jubeen, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry was the focal person of the webinar. Two resource persons Dr. Muhammad Zubair from the Department of Chemistry, University of Gujrat, and Dr. Mazhar Iqbal from Department of Environmental Sciences, Quad-i-Azam university delivered talks in the webinar. 146 faculty members, researchers, and students from various universities and research institutes attended the webinar. The webinar was a step forward to develop a zero-emission policy from vehicles on the campus of GCWUF. Dr. Muhammad Zubair highlighted the current situation of air and water contaminated by automobile exhaust, combustion engines of various industries, and their impact on human health, he also highlighted certain environmental protection policies developed over the years in 1983, 1997, 2001, and 2005. He stressed the need for strict



implementation of these policies and the development of new policies as well. Dr. Mazhar Iqbal talked about "Reducing Toxicity of Heavy Metals in Plants using Different Amendments & Microbes" and highlighted how the penetration of heavy metals through soil can affect mitochondrial respiration in plants and can lead to damaging effects in different plant parts which ultimately lead to contamination of human food supply. He also enforced the need to develop policies for food safety monitoring and their strict implementation. Dr. Nazli gave her concluding remarks regarding both the talks. Prof. Dr. Robina Farooq highly appreciated the talks of both speakers and gave her viewpoint of transforming to a pollution-free environment by encompassing artificial intelligence.

The last module of Faculty Development Training was conducted by Dr. Zill-i-Huma Nazli, Director Academics GCWUF entitled "General Rules and Regulations".
